General Guidelines :

Eligibility :- (Ref :- Railway Board's L. NO. 2019/E(Trg)/30/75 dated 29/04/2019)

Any Indian national pursuing Graduation/Post Graduation in Engineering (Civil, Electrical, Mechanical & Electronics, Computer disciplines only), Transportation Technology, Transportation Management or MBA from institutes of National & International repute is eligible to apply.


- a) Students pursuing Post Graduation in Engineering should have obtained a first class Graduate Degree.
- b) Students pursuing undergraduate course in Engineering should have completed at least two years of study in degree & should have a consistently good academic record.
- c) Students pursuing MBA should have obtained a first class Graduate Degree & have successfully completed one year of the course.
- d) Students pursuing B.Sc.(Transport Technology) or BBA in Transportation Management have completed at least one year of study in the degree.

Duration :- Duration of the internship will be two months (maximum).

Special Conditions : (For the period of current pandemic situation only)

In view of the Pandemic situations presently prevailing in the country, the following guidelines are prepared to be followed by the candidates want to join as vocational trainees in TTC/RCF :

1. In the current pandemic situations candidates from within the state & wards of RCF officials or recommended by RCF officials will be considered for vocational training in TTC/RCF.
2. The candidate want to join as vocational trainees must have "Aarogya Settu" mobile app downloaded in his/her mobile phone.
3. At the time of joining he/she has to submit 48 hour old **Covid-19 negative report** to training coordinator.
4. In case of his/her sickness during the training he/she will not come to the training institute & will inform to his/her training coordinators accordingly & will work from home upon the project, if possible.
5. In case during training he/she availed leave to travel out of the state, he/she has to adhere to the guidelines of home quarantine as per latest guidelines of RCF administration/ MHA.
6. During training at TTC/RCF he/she will have to wear proper mask, maintain proper distance with other people and will have to follow proper sanitization measures as per guidelines.
